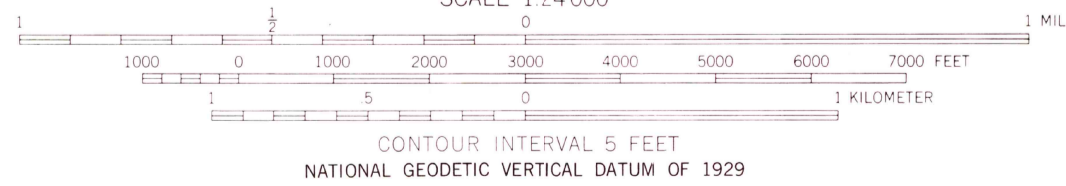
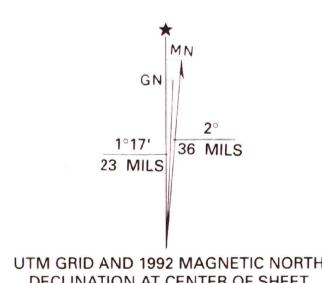
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Planimetry by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1964. Topography by planimetric surveys 1965
