

**Ground Water Control  
Unit To Be Visited.**

The largest experiment area for study of ground water control in central United States will be inspected by state flood control and Planning Board leaders Friday near Oden, Montgomery county. Members of the state Flood Control Commission and the Water Resources Committee of the state Planning Board will be the guests of H. G. Meginnis of New Orleans, regional technician in charge of water run-off surveys, and officials of the Ouachita National Forest area.

An effort is being made with mechanical devices to determine the basic factors governing ground water control on the 8,000-acre tract. The studies include the effect of reforestation in holding water to certain districts.
